SAFETY IN ELECTRICITY UTILISATION

The Zimbabwe standard safety code for the electrical wiring of premises (also known as the **SAZ Wiring Rules**) - **SAZS 400:2006** was published by the Standards Association of Zimbabwe in consultation with government departments, scientific, industrial and other organisations. These rules supersede **SAZS CC1: 1964 Wiring rules** (6th edition), which is now withdrawn.

These rules are designed to ensure safety in the utilisation of electricity in or on premises and cover the design, selection, erection, inspection and testing of electrical installations. They apply to installations in common use where the design current of the installation does not exceed 100 Amperes per phase.
